<p>Computing Device</p>	<p>St. Andrew's has WiFi in all classrooms and buildings and also in some outdoor spaces as well. St. Andrew's students will need a laptop computer. A laptop offers the most options for creating content and exploring learning resources. <p>Printer</p>	<p>An at-home printer is strongly suggested, but not required, as most assignments will be uploaded into Moodle.</p>
